

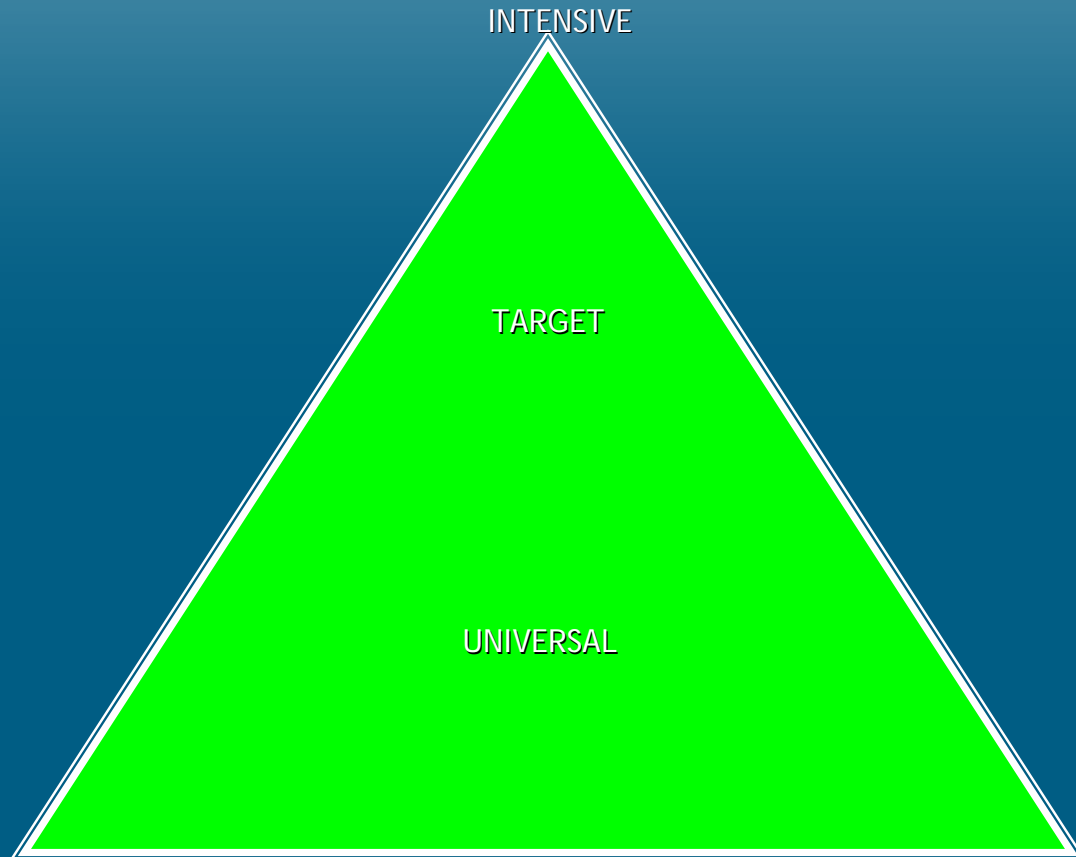

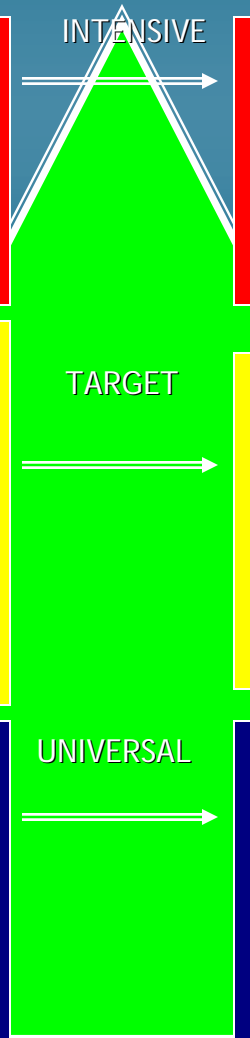

- Referral/Request for IMPACT/ARD/504
- Level of Support is Determined by:
 - Campus IMPACT Team, or
 - Special Education ARD Process, or
 - 504 Process
- Includes Parent, Student Participation




Access to Service ...

- PBS is a Universal Service being implemented on campuses over time
