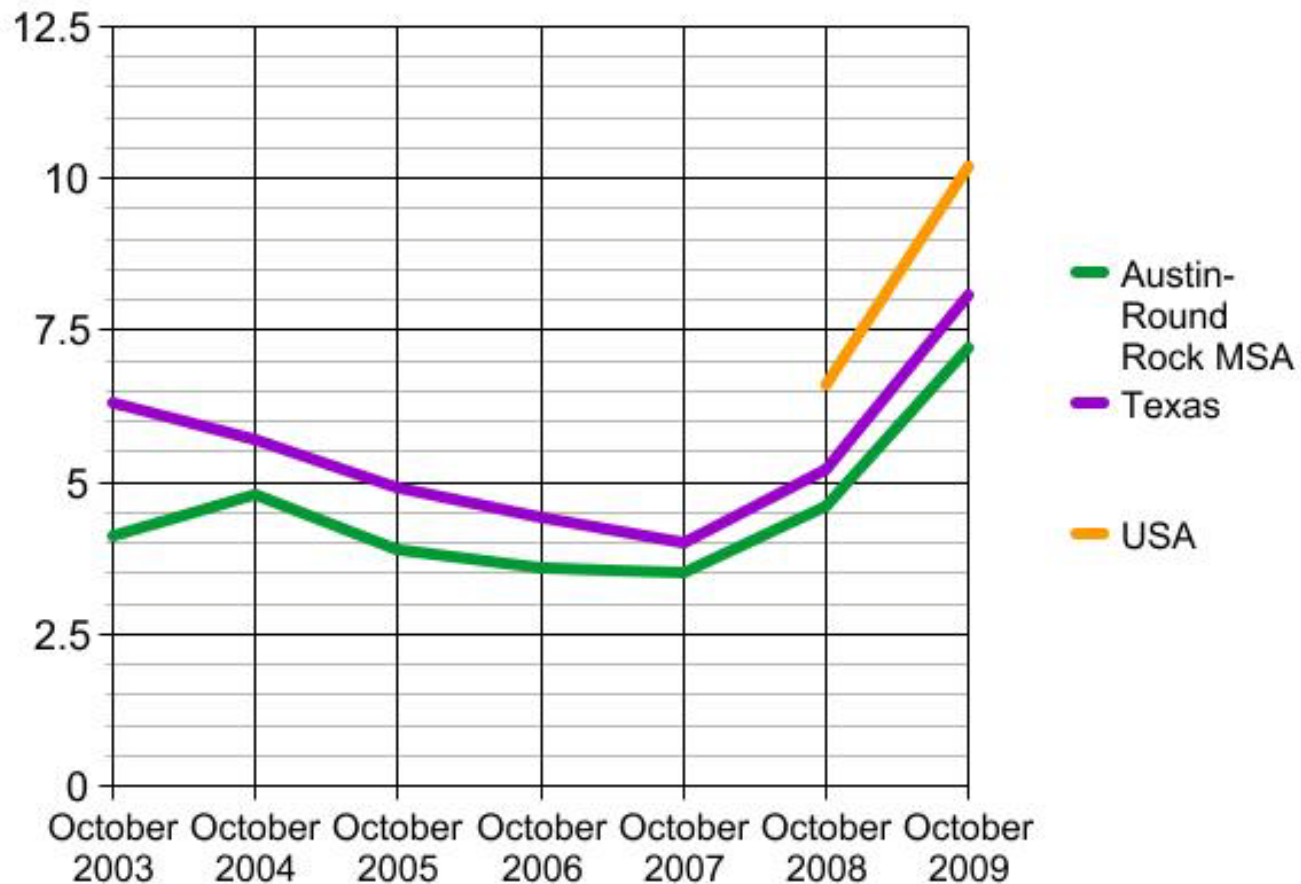

Potential Workforce Indicators

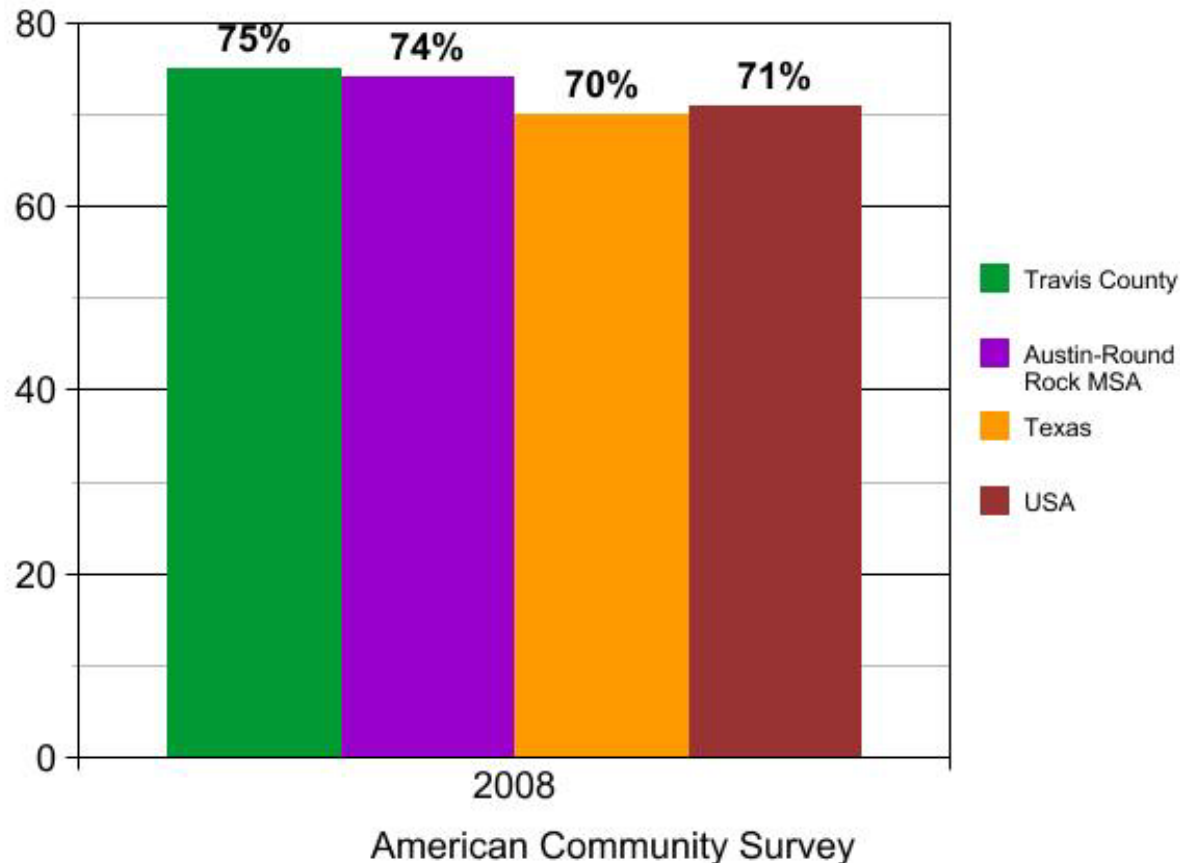
Unemployment Rate

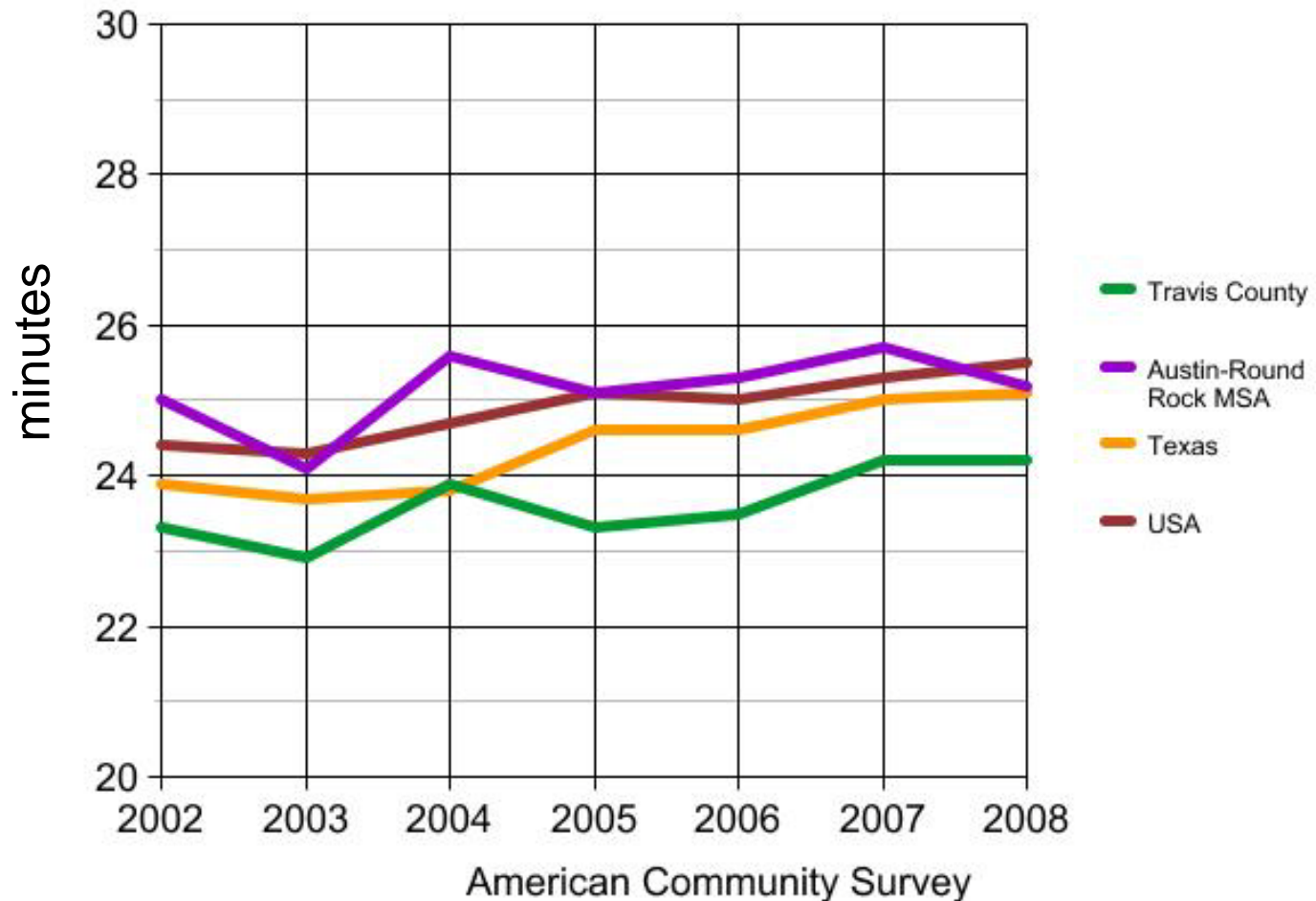
Potential Workforce Indicators

Employment to Population Ratio for all people aged 16 - 64



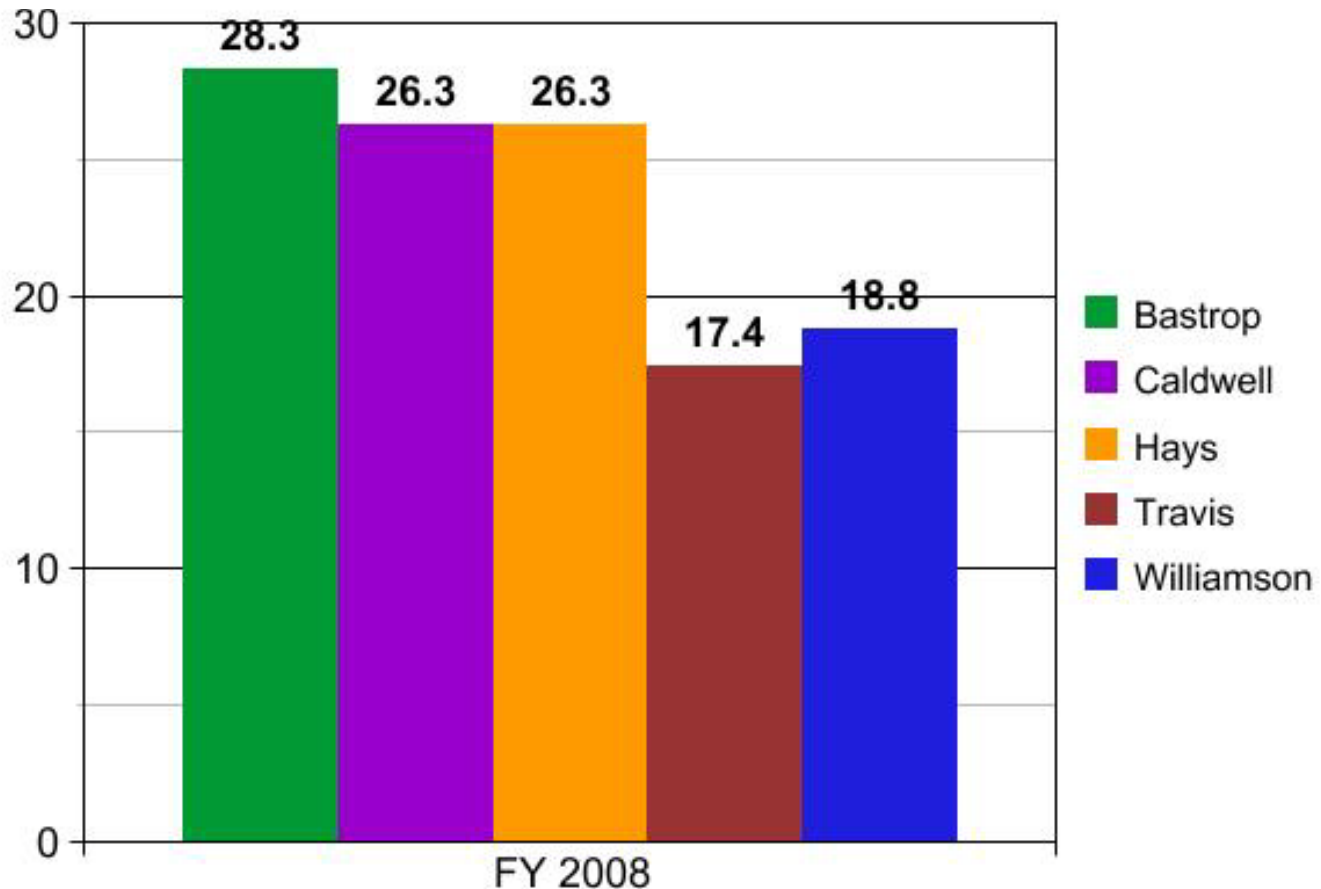
Potential Transportation Indicators

Food Security

- Capital Area Food Bank is developing a food security index
- Dashboard Steering Committee recommends removing food security as an indicator on the dashboard but linking to CAFB hunger dashboard in the CAN report.
- Re-evaluate whether to add to CAN dashboard in one year.



Do we assign a status?

1. Quantitative analysis – measures numerical progress toward a specific goal
2. Qualitative analysis – subjective assignment based on data, trends & gaps
3. No status – rely on text to explain relevance
