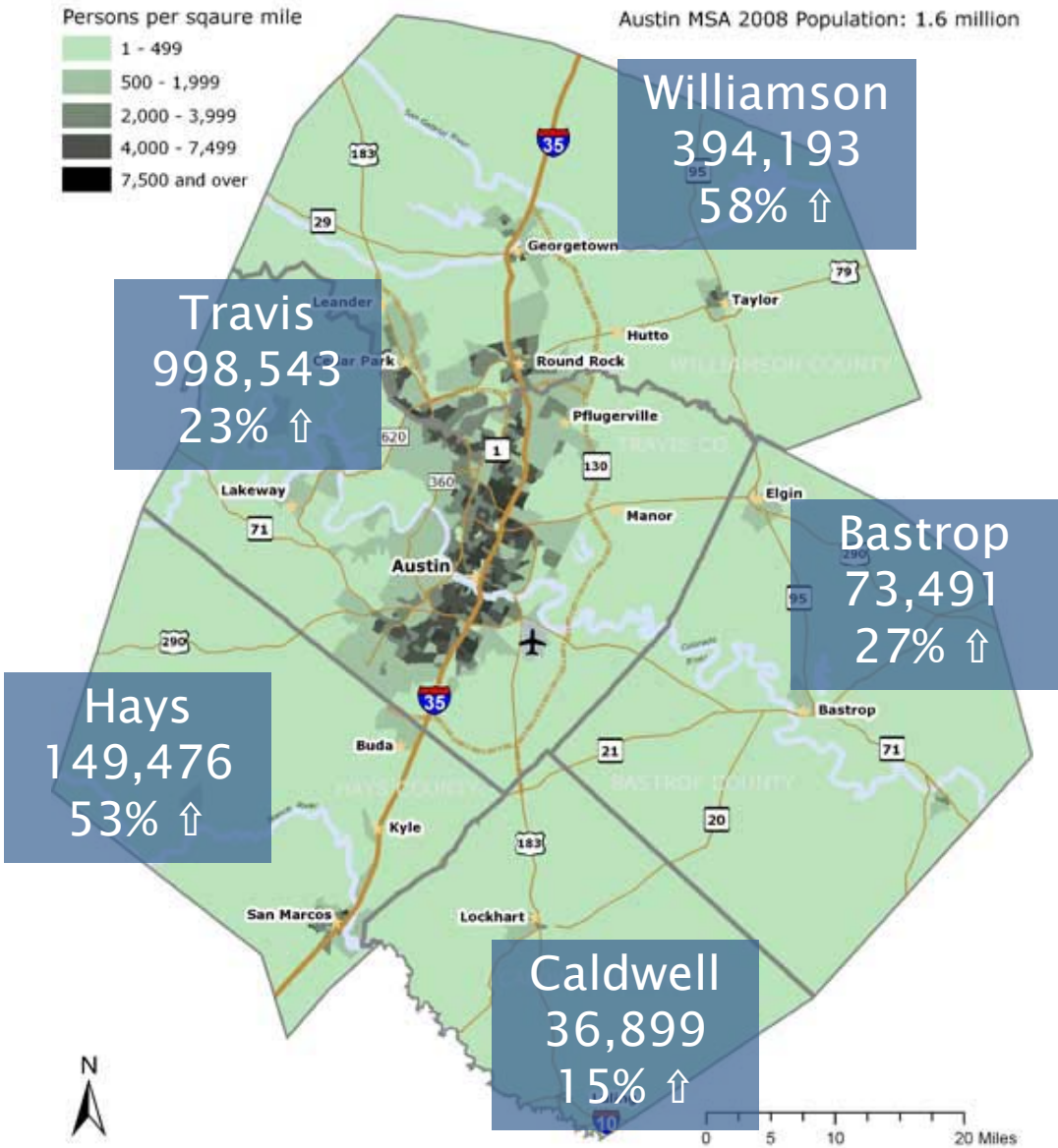
Community Dashboard

- Indicators will measure 5-county MSA, where available
- Drill-down
 - Geographic and demographic disparities
 - Status – where do we stand?

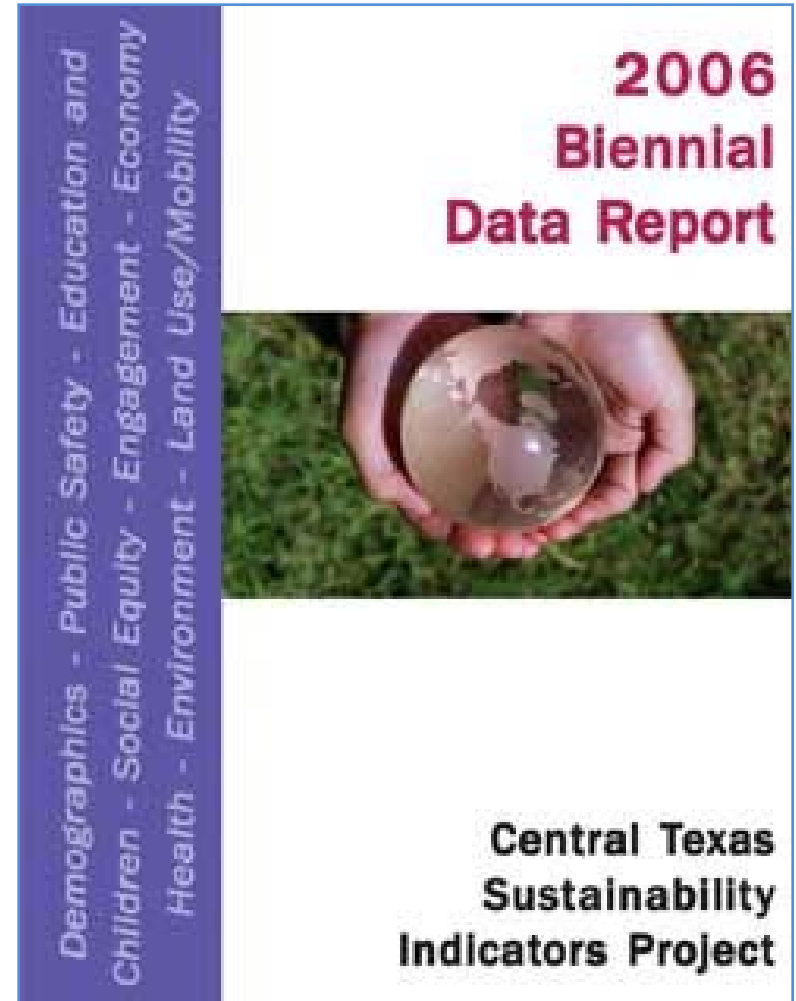

- Trusted data warehouse
- Regular trend and data reports
- 6 counties (MSA + Burnet)
- New partnership with UT Austin and TateAustinHahn
- 40 indicators
- Analysis of the impact of indicators
- Collaborate on strategies and actions



Opportunity Mapping Project Green Doors / Kirwan Institute

- **Maps of opportunity areas based on Kirwan Institute methodology:**
 - Education (6 indicators)
 - Environment and Public Health (13 indicators)
 - Economic Opportunity and Mobility (8 indicators)
 - Housing and Neighborhoods (11 indicators)
- **Funded by Green Doors**
- **Austin area only**
- **Goal is for policy and planning entities to use map to assess which parts of Austin are low or high opportunity areas**
- **Maps offer a different way to measure progress made**
