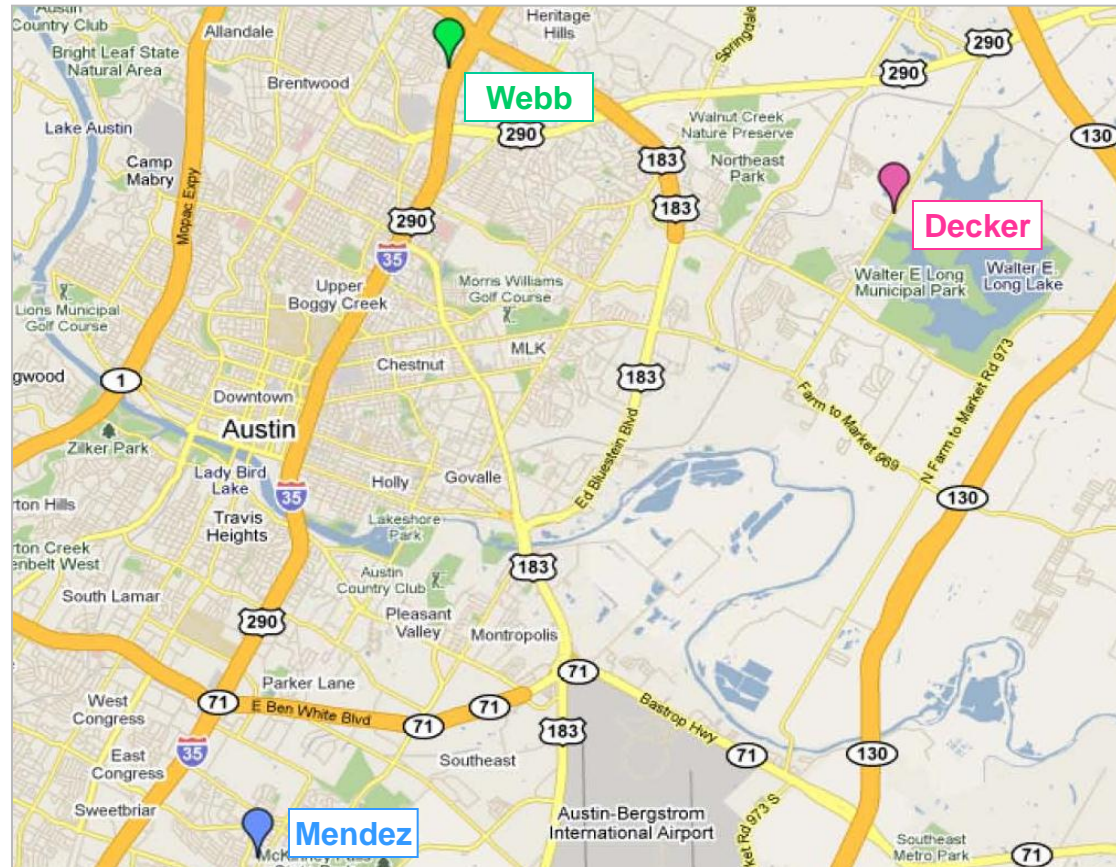
Youth Education Plan and Strategy Review

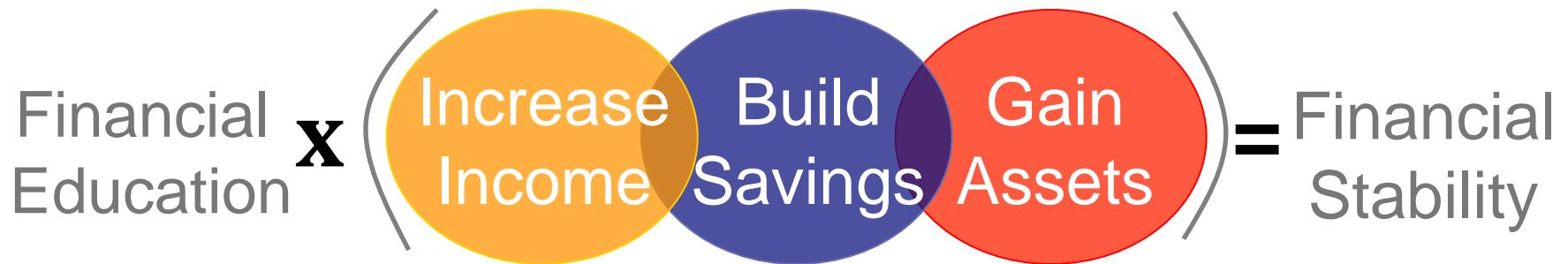

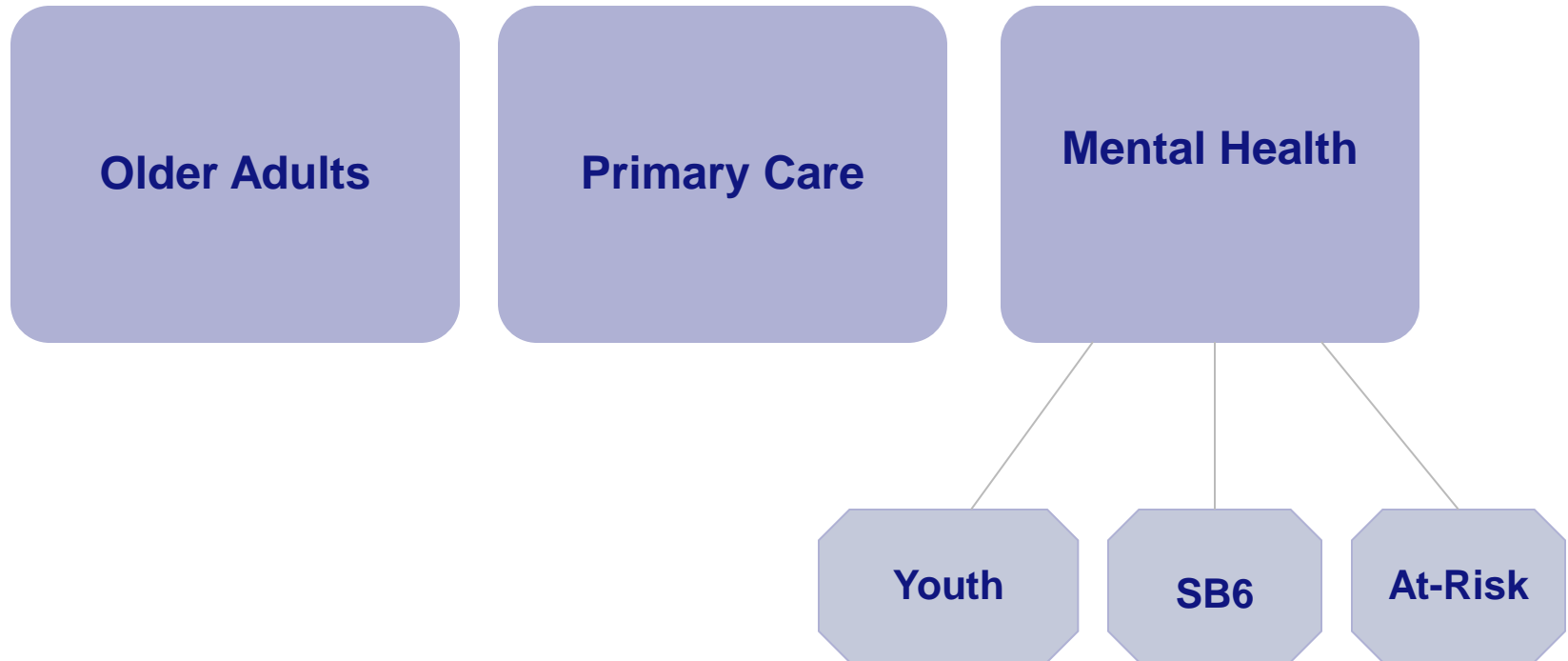

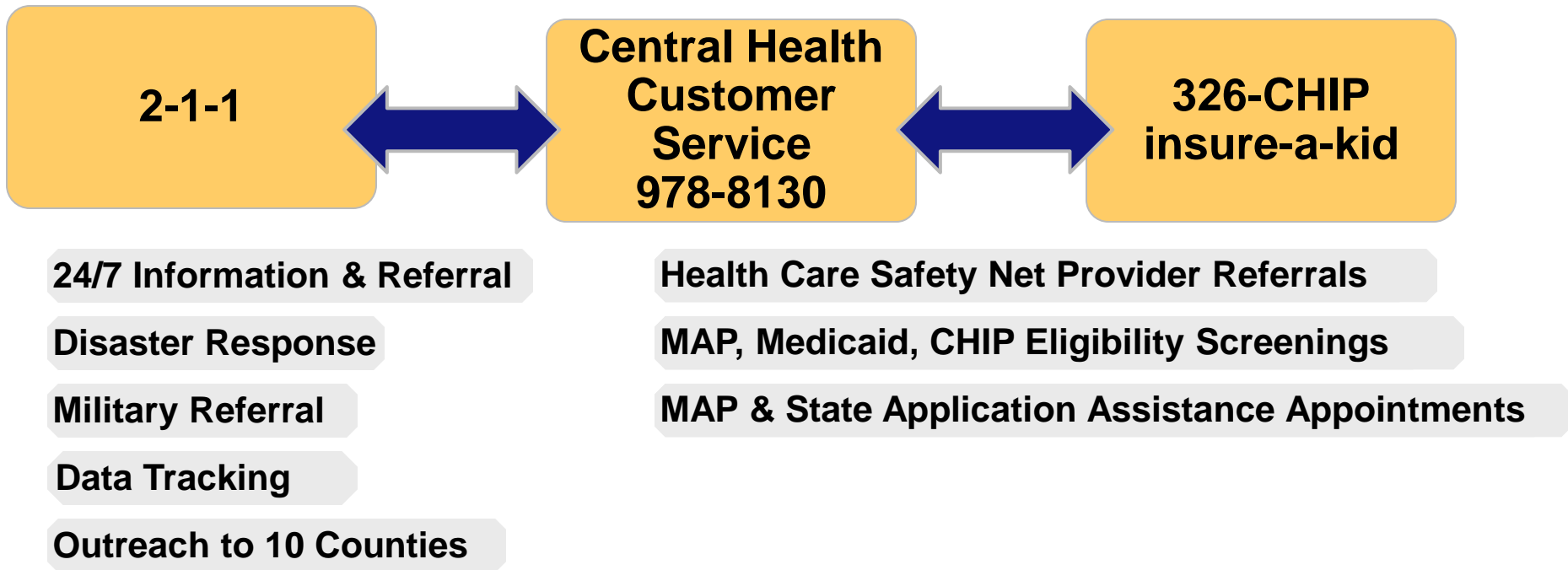
